

COVID-19 Policies for Little Star Daycare

Beginning Nov 2, 2020

Drop Off:

1. (Prior to drop off) Complete online health screening for each child – link found in HiMama
2. Wash hands
3. Only one adult in the building dropping off

Pick Up:

1. Wash hands
2. Only one adult in the building to pick up

Masks must be worn by:

- Children over the age of 6
- All adults/teachers

If you and/or someone in your household has been around someone for more than 15 minutes who has tested positive for COVID-19:

- That person who was in direct contact must quarantine for 14 days. Day 0 marks the day of contact.
- Before the person who was in direct contact can enter the building, a negative test must be shown and approved by Director, Krystina Schumacher. It is recommended to be tested 5 days after the day contact was made (A negative COVID test does NOT negate quarantine)

If you test positive for COVID-19:

- Complete isolation for 10 days. Day 0 marks the day the test was taken
- Only when symptoms are gone (for 24 hours) can you enter the building.
- Anyone in your household will begin quarantine AFTER your 10 days has passed, for symptoms can pop up any time between 2-14 days after exposure.

Notes:

- If at any point, you or someone in your household gets tested, your child may not return to daycare until that COVID test result comes back
- If your child is experiencing a fever (100.4) – they may not return until they have been fever free without the use of medication for 48 hours
- If your child is experiencing any two of the COVID symptoms, we ask that your child get a COVID test and quarantine until test results return (symptoms listed on page 3)

Quarantine includes:

- NOT leaving for work, school or other activities. STAY HOME.

Isolation includes:

- NOT leaving for work, school or other activities. STAY HOME AND AWAY FROM OTHERS IN YOUR HOUSEHOLD.

Other Notes:

- You will be billed regardless of attendance. The only time you will not be charged, is if the entire classroom must be shut down.

COVID-19 Exposure Guidelines

Person who is positive with COVID-19



Before returning to work or other activity, a person who is positive with COVID-19 must:

- **be in isolation at home for 10 days**
- be fever free for 24 hours
- AND have improvement in symptoms

Close Contact (Within 6 ft for 15 min.)



Close contacts need to:

- **quarantine at home for 14 days**
- monitor for symptoms

A test is recommended. A negative result will not end quarantine early.

Someone who is a Contact of a Close Contact



Someone who is a Contact of a Close Contact does not need to self-quarantine or be placed on any restrictions.
